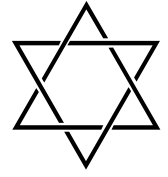


Lech Lecha (Go Forth Yourself)

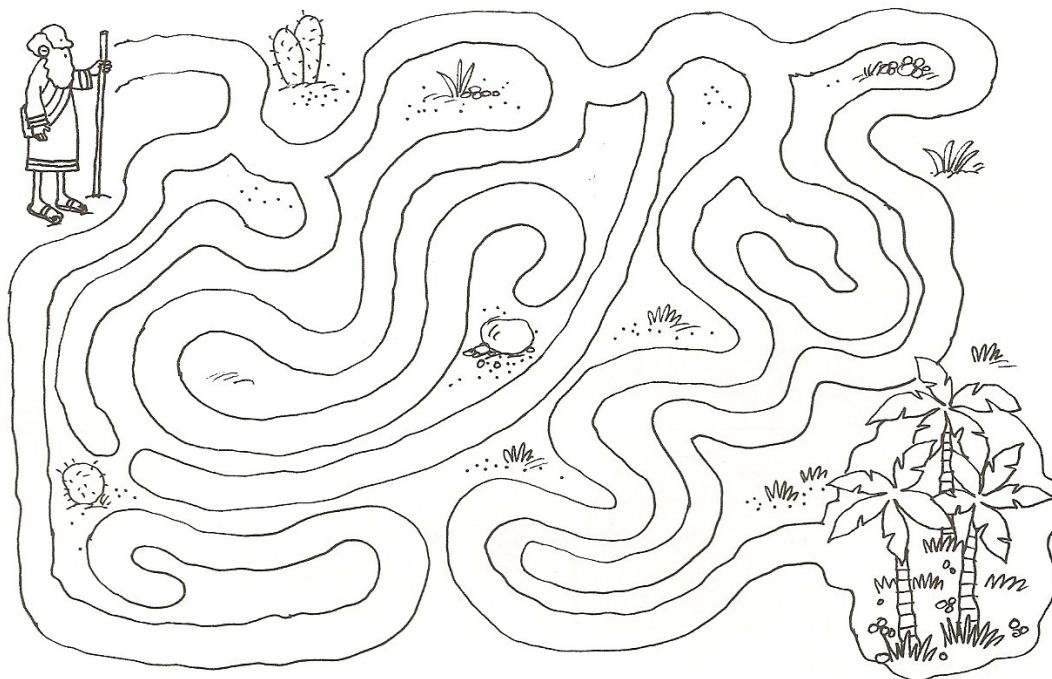
God Called Abram Puzzle

God called Abram to travel from his home in Ur to the Promised Land. Find the mistakes in this picture of Abram traveling to the Promised Land. Color the picture when finished.



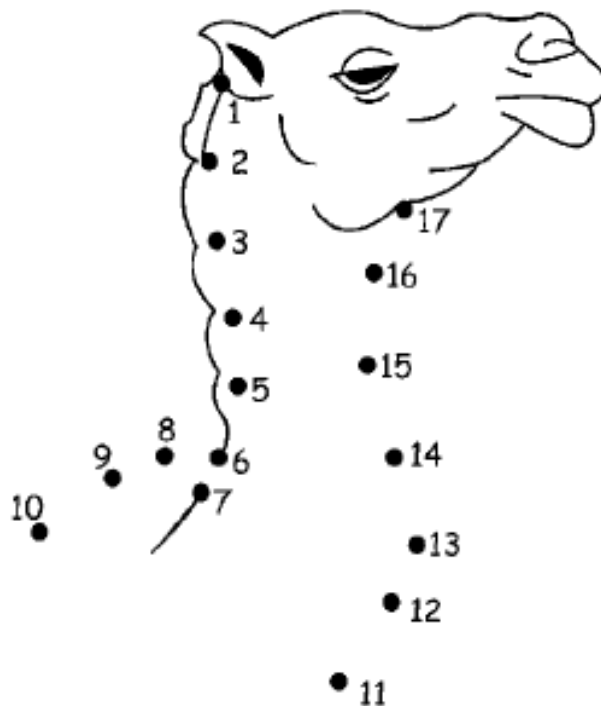
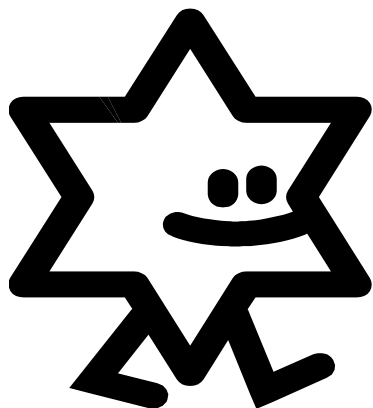
The Amazing Maze
