Parasha 49 - Deuteronomy/Devarim 21:1-25:19 — Elementary Lessons

THE STORY

When Yeshua was twelve years old, Yoseph (Joseph) and Miriam (Mary) took Him to Jerusalem for the Passover feast. The city was full of people. On the last day of the festival Miriam and Yoseph left to go home. They both thought Yeshua was with the other children who were going back to Nazareth.

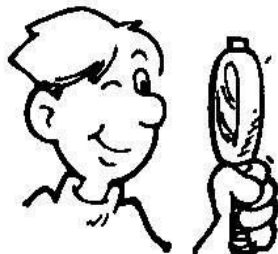
After a whole day of traveling, they asked the other children from the group. “Have you seen Yeshua?” The children shook their heads. Miriam and Yoseph looked at each other. Yeshua was still back in Jerusalem! How would they ever find Him? They left the group and hurried back to the city. There they looked everywhere for Him. They saw many children but none of them was Yeshua. For three days they searched high and low until they began to feel desperate. They had lost their precious Son, God’s Son.

Finally, they went to the temple where the Jewish people worshiped on the Sabbath and holy days. As they entered, Yoseph spotted a group of teachers listening to someone. There in the middle of the group sat Yeshua, He was the one to whom everyone was listening.

Yoseph and Miriam walked toward Yeshua. When they reached Him, Miriam said. “Child, why didn’t You try to find us?” “We’ve looked everywhere for You. We were so worried.” Yeshua said, “Why didn’t you know where to look?” You should have known I had to be doing my Father’s work.” Yeshua meant that since He was God’s Son, he would be in the temple, His Father’s house. As they left the temple with Yeshua, they heard many people say, “How can such a young boy talk as wisely as He did?” Yeshua returned with His parents to Nazareth. Yeshua was a good boy and did what His parents told Him, these were special years.

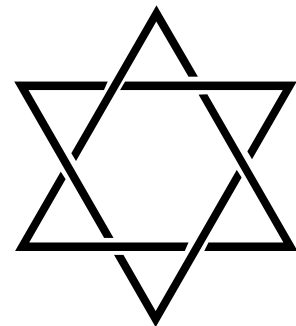

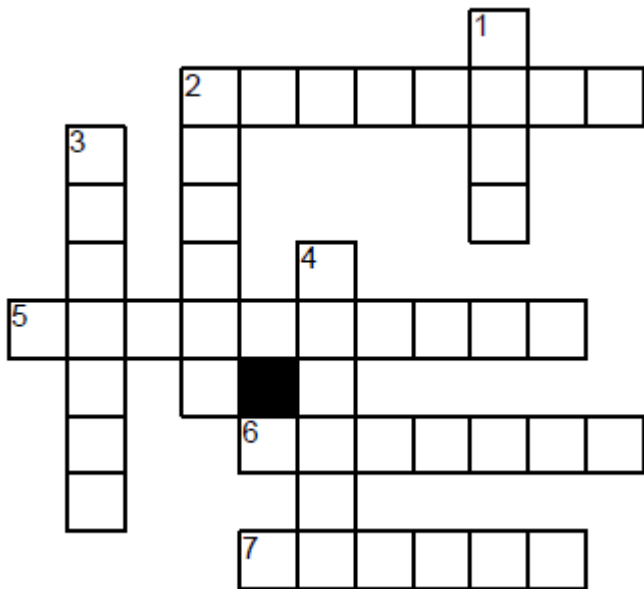

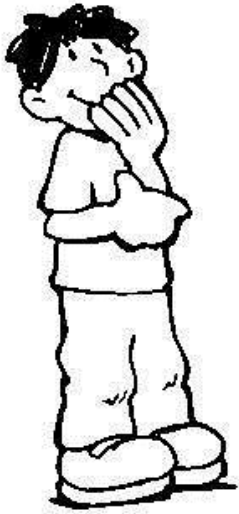
